

Subject: Implementation of Flexible Complementing Scheme to the Scientists working in Directorate of Forensic Science Services and its outlying Units – CFSs, Hi-Tech CFI's including GEQD.

Based on the recommendations of the 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission, the Department of Personnel and Training issued orders regarding introduction of Modified Flexible Complementing Scheme (FCS) for Scientists vide their O.M.
